**SANTA CLARA COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION  
RESOLUTION No: 2449-4**

**WHEREAS**, the governing board of the Santa Clara County Board of Education, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code 60119, held a public hearing on October 2, 2024, at approximately 5:00 p.m., which is on or before the eighth week of school and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing board provided a notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the county that stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing board encouraged participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing; and

**WHEREAS**, information provided at the public hearing and to the governing board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners, in the district/county office of education; and

**WHEREAS**, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home; and

**WHEREAS**, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners, in mathematics, science, history-social science, and English/language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program, consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks; and


