General Description

Under the direct supervision of the Director, Environmental Education, the Outdoor School Nurse serves as

a team member with support personnel to provide an educational program which promotes the physical, emotional and mental health of students served by the Santa Clara County Office of Education.

Certification and Education

Current RN License; Bachelor's degree in Nursing; California Driver's License; current CPR Certification; School Nurse Services Credential.

Knowledge, Abilities and Experience

Knowledge of and ability to apply appropriate scientific theory as basis for decision making in nursing

Refers student and his/her parent or guardian to appropriate community resources; provides input in Health Education Curriculum development and instructional delivery systems; keeps appropriate

administrators and program managers informed of legal provisions pertaining to school health; serves on curriculum development committees as requested; initiates and implements staff development in-service programs; attends staff meetings and other assigned meetings as required; provides health education curricula units for classroom use as requested; provides health education to parents; complies with state required data collection and reporting regulations; assumes other related duties as directed by administration.
