2. Countywide Equalization of Base Rates and Elimination of MOU 1 & MOU 2

It is recommended that the SELPA VII Executive Council approve the Countywide Equalization of Base Rates and Elimination of MOU 1 & MOU 2 outlined below, as recommended by SELPA VII special education program and fiscal representatives.

- Eliminate MOU 1 and MOU 2

- Notes: Dr. Dewan reports that SE SELPA does not want to eliminate MOU 1 and 2 until there is a countywide discussion first. The motion is tabled.

Dr. Mary Ann Dewan reported that the South East SELPA Consortium does not want to eliminate MOUs 1 and 2 until a countywide conversation at the superintendent level is held.
